I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. **In-season scratches are subject to inspection.**

**Use of cell phones on courses during the trial is strictly prohibited.**

**A Charter Arms Pro 22 Blank Pistol will be awarded to the winner of the Amateur Gundog.**

Rosettes will be awarded to all placing dogs.

**Placing dogs in all stakes will be credited with points towards the Association of Virginia Field Trial Clubs (AVFTC) Dog of the Year Awards.**
